Biblical preaching by Haddon Robinson has been a great help to me in learning to develop well thought out and biblical sermons. It is clear that Robinson has a great deal of experience in communicating messages from God's word.

He spends the majority of the book on how to develop expository sermons and uses a short portion at the end of the book to make mention of some helpful tips on how to deliver those messages. Throughout each chapter he works through the ideas behind each step of the process in building a biblical sermon. Not only does he do well explaining these ideas but the chapters are full of examples so that the reader can see the ideas in practice. These are very helpful, but there are a few places where the examples are so many that it seems tedious or redundant. These occasions are few though in his book.

The book also includes exercises in the back with a guide that may prove helpful to younger or new preachers in developing good habits and skills.

This book would be helpful to preachers of any age or experience level. The more experienced preachers who recommended this book to me remarked that they have found re-reading the book to be a helpful exercise in reminder for their preaching.
