

BOYS Studies

Brotherhood of Yahweh's Sons (BOYS)

Theme verse Isaiah 1:17

This effort is directed toward boys who are approximately 9-11. Timing can vary but my recommendation is once a month for about a half a day each time.

1. Study one chapter a month from Sewell's book: Jesus, a model of manhood
2. Spend an hour or so studying a text that helps them see the character of godliness they need to have. (Fruit of the Spirit; Psalm 15, ...)
3. Prepare questions we would like to learn from a specific person (mostly men and women in the congregation).
4. Visit that person with the express purpose of learning from them, not just visiting with them. If the person for that month lives elsewhere we can zoom them in.
5. Pray together about things that are going on in the boy's lives and also in the congregation.
6. Write cards to someone who lives elsewhere (preachers in isolated places, members who have moved away, men who should be our heroes, ...)
